III. CALL TO ORDER

IV. CAPTAIN'S REPORT (Barbara Competello)

- Barbara welcomed our new members and introductions were made.
- > 24 members participated in the Tuesday Ladies Day play
- Skins game will be played on Thursdays. Debbie Fuetsch asked if the Skins game day could be moved to another day of the week as Thursday conflicts with Graeagle Meadows Ladies group regular play day. Barbara said the WHRLGC Board will assess the feasibility of this for next season.
- The suggestion of forming a 9 hole group and reserving a weekly afternoon tee time was brought up. There was no interest in pursuing this at this time.
- We will try to get some 'Rules Clinics' scheduled.

V. TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR REPORT (Cindy Hannah)

- Today's Ace of Aces results: Brenda Knott had the low gross score and Ginger Holladay Houston and Betty Lease tied for low net. Betty won in a card playoff.
- Scores will be posted by Cindy for Tuesday Play Days. Members should post their own scores for any other days that they play, including the Thursday skins game.
- Cindy reminded the membership about the importance of pace of play. A
 Pace of play handout was provided to the members and is also posted on
 the website. You will find times noted on the bottom of the scorecard this
 represents the time that you should be finished on a hole.

- Graehawk Cup: Barbara said this tournament was started last year and Whitehawk won. Brenda recently sent our a save the date for this year's tournament which will be held on June 24th (at WH playing from the 1 ½ tees) and June 26th (at GM playing from the red/green combo). Those not participating in the tournament are encouraged to sign up to follow the field.
- Thursday Play Days will be a Skins game (net and gross). 3 tee times reserved. \$5 buy-in for those interested in participating. Leslie is the lead.
- Battle of the Sexes 7/6/25. JoAnn is the lead and will be sending out more information soon. There will be 20 24 players (12 women and 12 men). This shotgun start match play tournament will start and noon and be followed by dinner.

VI. INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT (Leslie Curry)

- The theme is Around the World in 18 holes and costumes are encouraged, but not mandatory.
- The event is now sold out (18 teams) and a waitlist will be started.
- Day 1 Lightning bolt scramble, Step Aside format, \$5 buy in. Dinner to follow.
- Day 2 Format Stableford 2 best ball. We will plan to use this format at one of the regular Tuesday Play Days so that the membership can become familiar with it. Lunch will follow at the Community Center.
- Leslie is seeking donations of wine (for the raffle baskets) and used golf balls (for decorations).
- \$100 hole sponsorships are available. Talk with Leslie no later than July 1st if you are interested in sponsoring a hole.
- If you are interested in reserving a tee time for a practice round on Monday, July 21st, talk with Mike Holmes. The rate will be \$99.
- Tournament cost will be \$85 for Whitehawk Ranch Golf Club annual members and \$165 for guests and non-annual WHR members. \$99 of the guest fee goes towards the greens fee and the rest goes towards payouts, tee prizes and lunch.
- Some of our WHRLGC members, who also belong to Graeagle Meadows, raised the issue of the tournament fee they are paying vs what the Whitehawk Ranch Golf Club annual members pay. The GM players pay \$89/round at WH. Debbie Fuetsch will check to see what GM charges for their Invitational tournament. This will be discussed at an upcoming WHRLGC Board meeting regarding the plan for next year.

VII. FINANCIAL REPORT (Brenda Knott)

- The 2025 budget was created and approved by the WHRLGC Board.
- 2025 changes: we will not be participating in the NCGA Zone Championship
- We will no longer be printing and distributing a member directory booklet. That information can now be found on the WHRLGC website.

- NCGA fees were \$46/person (vs \$49/person last year).
